"Blessing One Another"

(The following is shared by Pastor Alan Williams, one of the HGLC Visitation Pastors who offered this recently. It provides some appropriate suggestions during this month in which we think about our many blessings!)

I watched a video about the importance of spouses blessing each other every day. It also spoke of parents blessing their children and the children, their parents, each day. My wife and I have been doing that for several weeks and it has pulled the Lord more into our relationship than He already was. You might try blessing one another. Here is the blessing this pastoral couple used broken into three blessings:

1. May the favor of the Lord rest on you and may the Lord release His blessing in your life. May the name of the Lord be put upon you and may you succeed in all you do. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

2. May the Lord bless the labors of your hands and bless your relationships with your household and may the Lord enliven your heart to remember that life and death are in the power of your tongue. May the peace of God dwell in your life. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

3. May you be blest in your spirit and your soul in every fiber of your being. May you experience friendship with the living God. May you experience the peace that passes anything you've comprehended and may you encounter the love of God. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

There are also traditional blessings such as:

~May the Lord go before you to show you the way, behind you to encourage you, beside you to befriend you, above you to watch over you and within you to give you peace. Amen.

~May God who goes before you through desert places, by night and by day, be your companion and guide; may your journey be with the saints; may the Holy Spirit be your strength and Christ your clothing of light, both now and forever. Amen.

~Deep peace of the running wave to you, deep peace of the flowing air to you, deep peace of the quiet earth to you, deep peace of the shining stars to you, deep peace of the Son of peace to you. And may the blessing of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit be with you always. Amen. (Celtic blessing).

~Finally, the Aaronic blessing that God told Aaron to bless Israel can be found in Numbers 6:24-26: The Lord bless you and keep you, the Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you, the Lord lift up his countenance to you and give you peace. Amen.

The important thing is that you take a minute or two to bless each other. Begin the blessing with the person's name and with your hand on their shoulder. I challenge you to give it a try.

Congregational Meeting:

Sunday, Dec. 11th, is the date for the bi-annual congregational meeting after the 10:30am worship service. Four new council persons will be elected, a 2023 budget presented, reports and updates about the building program given, and other information shared. Building Program



The Building Program! The "soft start" on Phase One of the Master Site Plan has begun with work on the oldest structure on campus which is the Sunday House situated behind the two-story at 110 E. Creek St. This space will be converted into a prayer chapel. The latest news on when restoration for some of the bigger projects, like the bell tower, church and 110 E. Creek St., is that it will probably not start until the beginning of 2023 due to backed up work. In the meantime, please keep your donations and end of the year special gifts coming for this project, as well as your prayers!

A Word about a special TAX SAVINGS

Opportunity to Give: Required Minimum Distribution

The dreaded RMD, the requirement from the IRS that once we reach the age of 70 1/2, you must take distributions from your IRA, SEP, Simple, or retirement account. In most cases, this results in taxable income to add to the tax return in the year of the distribution. But wait! There is an exception! The IRS allows you to make a tax-free transfer to a charity of your choice from your retirement account. You don't need to itemize deductions to get the tax benefit. Making a tax-free transfer also keeps the money out of your gross income. That could help you avoid the Medicare high-income surcharge in certain tax brackets. Keeping money out of your adjusted gross income could also make less of your Social Security benefits taxable. Do you have an RMD this year? *Talk to your accountant and your broker* to see if you can designate some of the required amount paid to the charity of your choice. For example:

Required Minimum Distribution	\$ 5,000
Check from broker payable to the charity of your choice	\$ 1,000
Taxable distribution for 2022	\$ 4,000

AVENUES FOR CHURCH FINANCIAL SUPPORT!

1. Use your envelope system you receive in the mail. One is for the general fund which supports budgeted ministries and the other supports the Capital Campaign building program, Phase One!
2. Set up payments on-line with your bank (one time or recurring payments).
3. Set up payments through Realm/Vanco to use your credit card or your bank account for your gifts. If you have access to your personal account through the HGLC office software which is called "Realm," you can do this. If you do not have access to your personal account in Realm, please call the office and speak with Shanese or June who will gladly walk you through the process. Once you receive the invitation and respond to the email, you will be able to manage your giving on your Realm account with Vanco. It's simple and easy!
4. Go to the church website holymghostfbg.org, click on the Donate button at the top right of the page, and follow the prompts.

NOVEMBER WORSHIP THEMES



Messages in November: The sermon series for the next couple months is titled, *"Underestimating God!"* So often we cut the Lord short of what He ends up providing! Bible stories will be visited that remind us of God's great provision!

Sat. & Sun., Nov. 5 & 6: Our story is from John 11 regarding the death of Lazarus, brother to Mary and Martha. It is also All Saints weekend, as we remember those who have died in this last year from our Holy Ghost family of faith. Where do we underestimate God when it comes to death and life? After all, Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life. Do we truly believe this?

Sat. & Sun., Nov. 12-13: Our sermon series: *"Underestimating God"*, continues with the Prophet Elijah's cry to the Lord: "I'm the only one left!" The prophet Elijah was running for his life and complains to the Lord God that there is no one left on earth who is faithful to the Lord. But God reminds him that there are indeed 7,000 others who have not bowed the knee to other gods. Our reading is from 1 Kings, chapter 19 verses 9-18.

Sat. & Sun., Nov. 19 & 20: Possibly the most consistent place that we underestimate God is with His ability to erase our sins! Doubt, fear, and questions about whether we are truly forgiven can creep into our hearts as Satan whispers in our ear, "You cannot really be forgiven for what you did!" Christians, believe that the blood of Christ cleanses us from ALL sin—past, present and even future! Read John 8:1-11.

Wed., Nov 23—Thanksgiving Eve: Services are offered at 11am & 6:30pm with Holy Communion served! The evening worship celebrates the youth who have been studying the Sacrament as they are welcomed to the Lord's table! Come and give thanks unto God for the greatest of gifts—Jesus Christ, our Savior!

Sat. & Sun., Nov. 26-27: Our Advent series begins with "The King will Come!" based on Romans 13:11-12 and Matthew 24:36,42-44. King Jesus will indeed return to the earth, "but about that day or hour no one knows... so keep watch" (Mt. 24.)

Stained-Glass Windows on Web Site

Have you ever looked at something all your life but never knew the significance? A few weeks ago, while reading the history of Holy Ghost Lutheran Church and the history of the stained-glass windows, I realized for the first time that Jesus was walking on water in the painting behind the front church altar! It is a beautiful painting of Jesus, extending a hand of grace to Peter who is sinking in the waves. For decades, I never looked that closely. The historic collection (stained-glass windows) was restored and resurfaced with new protective exterior coverings in 2007. Did you know that a stained-glass window located in the sanctuary restroom was given in memory of three-year-old August Jost, Jr. (1929-1932), as a reminder of God's love in Jesus for all who have lost children? Did you know that the window in the room to the right of the sanctuary doors honors the 76 sons of this congregation who served during World War I, 1917-1918? 
