

"Intentional"

I love the word "intentional." It beckons us to action, focuses on discipline, and is steeped in purpose. Webster defines intentional as "intended; designed; done with design or purpose." Living our lives intentionally, with purpose and drive, can lead to great and powerful results. Cities, nations, farms and ranches, businesses big and small, and even many relationships can benefit greatly when intentional, driven people invest their time and energy into something or someone. A "can-do" attitude and follow-through can lead to great things. But there are limits.

In his explanation of the Apostles' Creed in the Small Catechism, Martin Luther wrote: "I believe that I cannot by my own understanding or effort believe in Jesus Christ my Lord or come to Him, but the Holy Spirit has called me through the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts and sanctified and kept me in true faith." Luther based this teaching on Scripture passages like Philippians 1:6: "And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ." (ESV) We are called to grow and mature in our faith. We are called to be intentional about things like prayer, worship, and giving. But as we pray, as we worship, as we read Scripture, and as we give, we are called to do so with great humility because, as the Scriptures tell us, God is the only one who can transform our lives, give us faith and give us the maturity of faith so many of us long for in this life. As C.S. Lewis wrote in Mere Christianity: "After the first few steps in the Christian life, we realize that everything which really needs to be done in our souls can be done only by God."

So, if God is the only one who can truly change us into the individuals and community we are called to be, why even try? One word: trust. "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." Proverbs 3:5-6 (ESV) Our calling is to live our lives every day trusting that Jesus meant what He said: "I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Mt. 28:20) The living Lord Jesus is with us right now, working in each one of our lives and in this community. He has a purpose and a plan for us. We are called to live intentional, purposeful lives filled with prayer, service, love, and worship. We are called to do so with humble hearts, knowing that even with all our efforts, it all comes to nothing without the Lord's presence and power. So trust in the Lord with all your heart! Pray, pray, pray. Love, love, love. Serve, serve, serve. Give, give, give. And above all, trust that God is and will continue to work intentionally in your life for His great and wonderful purposes!

BUILDING PROGRAM PROGRESS!

Koehler Construction Company continues to plug away at the project! <u>The basement</u> is now totally gutted and HVAC vents are being installed, electrical revamped, and plumbing shored-up for new and improved restrooms. The space will contain a large meeting area with several rooms for individual classes. It will not be a whole lot different from what was there, but much more upgraded from 1949 when the lower level was added. It has served us well for 74 years and now is ready for a make-over.

<u>The Bell Tower</u> will soon have a 90-foot scaffold placed around it so that restoration can begin on removing rotted and weakened wood and then shoring up the timbers. The lumber has carried the load of the structure since 1888. It will now be ready to stand steady for the next 135 years or more!

Soon to be addressed is the two-story Creek Street house which will be used for education and community ministries. The prayer chapel awaits custom made doors and windows as it continues to be worked on by HGLC volunteers.




COUNCIL NOTES June 19, 2023

- Pastor David led the meeting with a devotion about the "call 1. to ministry" with emphasis on the need for more pastors throughout the church as well as each of our calls to ministry in whatever vocation we have. Norm Nevins presented a copy of the HGLC security policy.






