## "Youth Ministry Direction at HGLC: Plant Corn!"

It's always interesting and a bit spiritually mysterious to experience how the Holy Spirit works—because at times trying to sense or read the movement of the Spirit is like trying to nail JELLO to the wall—it ain't happening!

There is a story about a wheat farmer who experienced three consecutive years of failed crops. He was now plowing in the spring of the year about to plant a fourth crop. As he plowed, he also was seeking to determine if God had a different direction for his life. He even prayed, "Lord, please guide my heart to what You would have me be doing in life."

Suddenly, there was a shift in the wind and the clouds above him separated into two distinct formations, creating a large letter "P" and "C" in the sky. The farmer immediately shouted, "I knew it-- P.C! God wants me to Preach Christ!" So the farmer sold the property, enrolled in a seminary where for four years he studied the Bible, learned the ministry and was taught what it was to be a pastor! Upon graduation he received a call to a small country church where after a year there, he failed miserably in that role!

Downtrodden and even a bit angry at God, the farmer pleaded, "Lord, I asked for Your direction and You sent a clear sign in the clouds indicating for me to: 'P.C.-- Preach Christ!' I have clearly obeyed You in following Your Will, so WHY, WHY have I failed at being a pastor?" The Lord spoke, "Dear farmer, yes you asked and my Spirit provided a true answer for you. 'P.C.' for a farmer does not mean preach Christ, but Plant Corn!"

At times when we pray for God's guidance the answer remains a mystery. Other times we pray and the answer may <u>be</u> as clear as day, and still on other occasions the answer may only <u>seem</u> as clear as day. But truth be told when it comes to discerning the direction of the Holy Spirit, we pray, read God's Word, visit with trusted Christian friends, and pray even more. And yet even when we may think things are fairly clear—we as followers of Christ, due to being limited humans and not fully knowing the mind of God - we don't always get it right, <u>OR</u> life's winds blow in a different direction and the landscape changes.

Such was the recent situation with Pastor Clint in his decision to step aside from being the HGLC Youth & Family Pastor. In January he announced that after eighteen years in this position he would be resigning it due to the prayerful understanding that for various good and solid reasons, now was the best time for him to do so. With sad hearts the church council received his decision. He would yet remain as part-time pastor at St. Paul, Cave Creek.

After weeks of prayer and discussion, during March and April the church council decided due to primarily financial reasons the two roles that had for the past nine years been led by Pastor Clint as Youth & Family Pastor and Daniel Hofmann as Children & Young Family Minister, would be rolled into one position. Daniel was invited to consider taking on the full youth program, birth to high school graduation and Pastor Clint was asked to consider a half-time position still working with confirmation and other areas non-related to youth. Both agreed to this arrangement with details to be worked out by the church council and a youth ministry task force.

Since that time, with the Spirit keeping Pastor Clint restless about his decision to be almost completely out of youth ministry, various experiences involving deep developed relationships over almost two decades of ministry came into play with a youth crisis in our community and specifically related with the school district where he has spent an enormous amount of time, energy, and faith leadership. The hours, days and weeks of ministry that then unfolded with students, families, teachers, administrators, athletes, counselors, HGLC church members and the broader community turned out to be the spiritual unveiling of the direction that Pastor Clint understood as the Holy Spirit leading him to still continue in some selected areas of youth ministry.

At the May church leadership meeting, the rich value of community ministry that HGLC is able to offer our church and town through Pastor Clint's leadership was weighed heavier than the earlier decisions. Hence, Daniel will lead as the overall Director of Youth & Family Ministry while maintaining his current area of responsibilities with children and young families and taking on additionally the junior high & high school ministries with specific areas of work that Pastor Clint will hand off. Pastor Clint will lead half-time, specifically with confirmation, WYWP, High School chaplaincy, and church missions and still plans to in time incrementally transition from youth ministry, but I guess we'll see what the Spirit has to say about that too!

May we always call upon the Holy Spirit to lead us where God would have us, and yet be open to when the winds change, and God says, "Plant Corn!" Amen? Amen! +Pastor Bobby Vitek




