

Rest and Relaxation

Joyce and I just got back from vacation. We had a great time. There are a couple of ways to spend your time on a vacation. One is to go somewhere fun and exciting and have all sorts of adventurous plans mapped out. Those can be some awesome vacations, but when I do one of those I usually wind up needing to have some vacation from my vacation, if you know what I mean.

The other type of vacation is to rest. That could mean booking some time at a beach or lake house or even spending some time in a cabin in the mountains (and out of the heat). We decided this year to drive up north and spend some time with Joyce's family. Some of them we have not seen in a few years. It wound up being very rewarding. Of course we also spent some extended time with our grandchildren who are still young enough to enjoy. And you can take a nap when they do!

Rest is built into creation. God rested on the seventh day from all His labors (Gen. 2:2). In Exodus 20, God built into the Ten Commandments a command to rest from our labors. We work hard, we play hard, and everyone of us needs rest. God built that into our systems so that we would take time to be rejuvenated.

In Mark 6:31 after Jesus had sent out the disciples two by two to begin doing the work He was doing, they came back together, and this is what Jesus tells them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while. For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat." They were in need of a break. That's what vacations are for: to take a break and give your whole body (spiritual, emotional, physical) a much needed rest.

One of the most powerful and inspirational passages about rest comes at the end of Matthew chapter 11. Jesus says, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

Wow! Just hearing those words from the mouth of Jesus gives me a sense of peace, knowing that no matter how tired or worn out or stressed or exhausted I am, my true rest is in Christ Jesus, our Lord. There is an old saying, "A burden shared is a burden cut in half, and a joy shared is a joy that is doubled." That's exactly what Jesus does for us! We can bring our burdens and lay them at His feet, and He helps us carry those burdens so they don't overwhelm us because He has already carried the greatest burden of all—the cross, bearing our sin and shame on His shoulders, and because of that we can find not only true rest in Him, but joy as well.

Be sure to take that Sabbath Day that God has given you each week, and take some vacation, as well, to get some extended rest. But know that each and every day you can place any or all cares in Jesus' hands, and you will find rest for your souls.

BUILDING PROGRAM UPDATE!

The scaffolding is up as all in the community can see! This means that the restoration work that is so badly needed to support the upper spire structure is underway! Rotted louvers are being replaced as well as the rock being re-pointed where needed. Inside the sanctuary, the fire suppression system is being installed, and the lower level has been "gutted" and is being renovated! At the same time, newly milled windows, doors, and siding are being placed in the old Sunday house which will be a prayer chapel. Soon to begin will be the work on the Creek Street two-story home which will then function as Sunday School, small group, and community ministry spaces. Koehler Construction Company continues to plug away at the project and says that the timeline for completion of the sanctuary will be September or October. Please pray for the safety of the workers engaged in these high heights. Also please keep your cards, letters, checks, on-line giving, and special gifts coming as we support not just the assembly of brick and mortar, but spaces that will feed souls as we seek to "Be and Make Disciples!"

AS WE CERTAINLY MISS WORSHIPING IN OUR

BELOVED SANCTUARY, some great things are happening in the Fellowship Hall worship space!! First of all, thanks be to GOD that we even have the hall to meet in! Purchased in 1999 and remodeled in 2008, the Fellowship Hall has been such a blessing, and we can't even imagine life without it!! Seventy-seven were in the Saturday evening worship, and instead of heading to their vehicles after the closing song, thirty-seven of them hung around for guite some time after the service in fellowship with one another! The energy, hunger, connecting, and community that is being experienced while in the Fellowship Hall is exactly what a narthex space will give us when we get to Phase 3, but that will be guite some time down the road. - 1. Use the envelope system you receive in the mail. One is for the general fund which supports budgeted ministries, and the other supports the Capital Campaign building program, Phase One!
- 2. Set up payments online with your bank (one time or recurring payments).
- 3. Set up payments through Realm/Vanco to use your credit card or your bank account for your gifts. If you have access to your personal account through the HGLC office software which is called "Realm," you can do this. If you do not have access to your personal account in Realm, please call the office and speak with Shanese or June who will gladly walk you through the process. Once you receive the invitation and respond to the email, you will be able to manage your giving on your Realm account with Vanco. It's simple and easy!
- 4. Go to the church website <u>holyghostfbg.org</u>, click on the Donate button at the top right of the page, and follow the prompts.
- 5. Text giving is now available. Simply text to: 73256. Type in the message of the text: HolyGhost. Hit Send. You will then receive a text message with the link to our HGLC Giving Form. This is what you will fill out to do your offering.

The radio station is changing out some equipment, so in the meantime the church service can be heard either on KNAF 107.9FM or AM910 on Sun. at 10am.



COUNCIL NOTES June 19, 2023

- 1. Pastor Steve opened with a devotion about the FIRE that gets created with the Holy Spirit, Scripture, and close community. (Ask him about it!)
- 2. David Bullion, chairperson of the building program, offered an update to the council on the progress of the project. (See related article.)
- 3. Desipte the relocation of worship from the sanctuary, the council celebrated all the great relational activity that is happening in the Fellowship Hall worship space.
- 4. Conversations about the April 2024 eclipse began and will continue after the area churches get together with the local planning team about best practices.
- 5. Rally Day will be Sun., Aug. 13 tto celebrate summer youth activities and dedicate the new school year.
- Fifty-five youth are attending Camp Chrysalis this year with Children, Youth & Family Director, Daniel Hofmann.
- 7. Bruce Christian shared that adult Sunday School plans are being shaped for the fall, dependent on space with the building project going on. (See related article.)
- 8. An update on parsonage #1 was given by Teresa Ganis, indicating the electrical & AC/H inspections are in motion.


