

The Majesty of God



April is fast approaching, and this year we are privileged to be able to witness the majesty of God as the heavens will align before us when the moon passes between the earth and the sun and we will get to witness a total solar eclipse. For many, this will be a once-in-a-lifetime event. We will experience that total eclipse for over four minutes in our area. That will be a sight to behold.

The Bible is filled with accounts that point to God's majesty and the wonders which God has created. One of those that comes to mind is Psalm 8 which begins and ends with these words, "O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!" Those bookends remind us that God is our Creator; He has made this earth and everything in it.

But there is more! Verses 3 and 4 tell us, "When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, ⁴ what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him?" If you have ever had a chance to be out in the country away from the city lights and just sat back or laid back and looked up at the heavens on a cloudless night, there are no words to describe the wonder and amazement of it all.

We need to do that more often—just take a break from the busy lives that we lead, sit back, gaze at the heavens, and ponder it all. How many galaxies are out there? How many stars? And how many planets are there orbiting those various stars? And is there life out there somewhere? Some of those are questions that will only be answered when we get to heaven. And if we think the view is amazing from the earth, just wait to see what God has in store for us in the future!

But there is more! Those next two verses open up for us an amazing revelation. "Yet you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. ⁶ You have given him dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under his feet." When you gaze at the awe and wonder of the heavens and then come back down to earth and realize that God has made us—humanity—to be the crown of His creation. And God has given us dominion to be caretakers and good stewards of all that He has created.

That is both frightening and awe-inspiring in the same breath, knowing that we are imperfect, sinful human beings, and God has placed everything in our care. That's the scary part. The inspiring piece in all of this is that God had a plan to save us. We have just celebrated Easter and are reminded that the same God who created all of this, the universe, the earth, and us, came down in the flesh among His creation. God sent His only begotten Son

to experience our life to the fullest. But the Good News, the Great News, is that Jesus came to redeem us. He went to the cross to pay the price for all of our mistakes and our sins, so that we would have a promise of eternal life and be able to see the majesty of God from heaven's perspective.

As wonderful as the eclipse will be, and as amazing as the stars are to gaze at, the greatest act of God was to bring life from death. That's what Jesus did on Easter to defeat sin, death, and the devil so that we might have forgiveness, life, and salvation. There is the true majesty of God!


Re-dedication of the Church: April 20-21!

APRIL WORSHIP THEMES

Messages in April: The Post-Easter Sermon Series for April and May is titled "The Grand Plan, Part II" and is a continuation of the Grand Plan Lenten series. This sequel will begin at the resurrection and lead us through Revelation.

Sat. & Sun., April 6 & 7: "40 Days/Jesus Displays" kicks off the post-Easter message series as some of the various appearances of Christ raised from the dead point to the reality of the resurrection from the dead.

Sat. & Sun., April 13 & 14: "The Grand Plan: Jesus Departed/Spirit Imparted". Jesus promised his disciples that a time would come when the Holy Spirit would come (John 16:7). The first two chapters of the Acts of the Apostles vividly describe our Lord's ascension and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. All of this is part of God's Grand Plan! Holy Communion will be served.

Sat. & Sun., April 20 & 21: "Started with Saul/Changed to Paul" is the theme for the weekend. Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 5 that "anyone who is in Christ is a new creation!" Changed for the better and transformed lives is what the resurrected Christ works in our hearts daily living! Need a change of heart? See you at church!

Sat. & Sun., April 27 & 28: The Grand Plan continues with "Mission Trips/Good News Lips." Jesus instructed the Disciples, before He ascended back into heaven, to take the show on the road. They were to share the Good News of the Gospel starting small - beginning with their own families, and communities, and then continuing to expand it to ever-widening circles until this Good News reached the ends of the earth and every person has a chance to hear about Jesus. How are we continuing to disciple others today? Holy Communion will be served.


