#### **New Things**

Isaiah 43:19 shares, "Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." It's always amazing to see the doors that God opens if we will simply trust in Him to lead and guide us. The congregation at the Special Meeting on May 18 got on board with a bold vision, that quite frankly, was a leap of faith. That vision was to hire both a Youth Minister to focus on Jr. High and High School youth and their families, while continuing the pursuit of an additional pastor to come on board and fill out our staffing needs.

As I write this, John LaRocque and his wife Carly, are making their way to Texas to start their journey with us. John will fill the youth ministry opening for our older youth and their families and work closely with the rest of the staff to strengthen our ministry to the youth of our community.

God has opened some amazing doors! We are blessed to have a pastoral candidate. Rev. Tobias Heike and his wife, Christie, will be visiting the congregation on the weekend of August 8-10. Tobias will preach at all services that weekend and be available to meet and greet the congregation during the Sunday School hour between services. The call committee had a very positive interview with him and has recommended him to the church council. We are looking forward to a great visit with him. We encourage folks to come to worship that weekend and meet and greet this pastoral candidate on August 9 & 10. His introduction follows:

#### A Letter from Tobias Heike

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

St. Paul teaches us that "...we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7). Some of us, it seems, just have to walk a little farther than others to follow the Lord's call! As I prepare to step on a plane and travel 5,194 miles to visit you, I can't help but marvel at the spiritual and physical paths God has laid before me — paths that now lead to the doors of Holy Ghost Lutheran Church in Fredericksburg, TX. But as Psalm 37:5 reminds us: "Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act." With that confidence in God's guidance, allow me to introduce myself:

My name is Tobias Heike, and I'm a Lutheran pastor-in-training from Germany, currently discerning a call to serve in the North American Lutheran Church. I'm married to Christie, my American high school sweetheart, whom I met during an exchange year in the U.S., and we have two daughters - Malin (11) and Kirsten (9).

I'm a second-career pastor, having recently retired from the German military where I served as an officer in various command and staff positions including overseas and deployment assignments. As my retirement approached, I began to reflect on my future, and though I felt the Holy Spirit gently drawing me toward ministry, part of me wondered if it was too late to take on such a calling. Then, without prompting, my wife, my pastor, and several elders in our congregation each encouraged me — independently — to consider pastoral ministry. As a military man, I took that as a clear order from above!

I enrolled at the Theological Seminary at the University of Greifswald and completed my studies shortly before my retirement last summer. As a family, we felt the time was right to return to the U.S. and seek a church home where we could serve and grow. Holy Ghost immediately stood out to us as a Bible-based, family-friendly, and inspiringly active congregation, where God's word is preached and where faith is lived out. We were also attracted by your impressive youth program for our two girls, many ministry opportunities for Christie, and a chance for me to grow as a pastor with the guidance of experienced pastoral mentors. We also feel drawn to Fredericksburg as an area on many levels, rural and peaceful, yet with a good infrastructure and access to urban areas — a perfect blend for us. I grew up in the German countryside and am an avid hunter and outdoorsman, while Christie, a university lecturer, was raised in U.S. East Coast suburbia. The balance would fit us well. And the many tie-ins to German culture in your area will hopefully lessen our culture shock after the transcontinental move significantly!

As a future pastor, I'm deeply rooted in the Lutheran confessions, committed to preaching Christ crucified for the forgiveness of sins, and passionate about teaching Scripture and walking alongside people in faith. Outside of church, I enjoy spending time in nature (hunting, fishing, hiking), and I love to cook and eat — especially barbecue and other savory dishes since I'm not much of a sweet

I'm truly excited for the opportunity to visit you in August. I look forward to getting to know you, worshiping alongside you, and prayerfully exploring what God may have in store for us — together.

Peace and joy to you in our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### **CHURCH COUNCIL NEWS**

#### COUNCIL NOTES July 21, 2025

- 1. The meeting opened at 6:00 with a devotion led by Pastor David about shining our light, the light of Christ, in the darkness of our world.
- 2. Heard a report from the Budget Task Force on concerns for a potential budget shortfall as we add staffing. The council voted to use the ERC (employee retention credit) monies to be set aside for any potential shortfall. They also voted to scale back the storage facility for the Klaerner property which also is in line with application for historic tax credits.
- 3. Rev. Tobias Heike, a pastoral candidate recommended by the call committee, will be with us August 7-10. He will preach at weekend services on August 9 & 10 and do a meet and greet during Sunday School that morning. The council has set a congregational meeting for August 17 following the 10:30 service to discuss his visit and whether to extend a call to him.
- 4. The parking lot task force has recommended placing signage on the East and South sides of the parking lot indicating the lots are primarily for Holy Ghost parking. With the increase in tourism, there has been a strain on our parking lot.
- Additional repairs on parsonage 3 to fix a roof leak and other items discovered at an additional cost of \$1,250.
- 6. It was voted to increase our personal dishonesty policy on the insurance for \$200,000 coverage at an annual cost of \$247.



- 7. We look forward to welcoming our new Youth Minister, John LaRocque, and his wife Carly. They will be here at the end of July, and he will officially be in the office on Monday, August 4.
- 8. Flood Relief. We continue to take monetary donations and are working closely with Zion Lutheran in Kerrville to distribute those funds where they are needed. Folks can volunteer. Please call the church office for more details.
- 9. Projector and screen have been installed in the Fellowship Hall, which will greatly enhance our hosting of the Global Leadership Summitt this year and many future events to come.
- 10. Regular meeting minutes and special meeting minutes to approve work on parsonage 3 were approved, along with the treasurer's report, noting that income for June versus expenses was a \$10,800 deficit.
- 11. Council paired up with prayer partners to close the meeting and adjourned at 8:02 pm.

#### Messages in August



August 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>: It is one thing to know about Jesus and quite another to believe and follow him. Jesus commands us: "Follow Me," and then in His wonderful, grace-filled way, He transforms our hearts, our minds and our lives as he gives us the heart, the means, and the will to "fish for people" and make disciples. Our Bible verses for the day are Matthew 4:18-20.

August 9th and 10th: Our pastoral candidate, Tobias Heike, will be preaching all weekend and will continue our theme of "Follow Me," by focusing on John 13:36: "Where I am going you cannot follow me now, but you will follow afterward." It is also Rally Day weekend.

<u>August 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup></u>: In John 10:27 Jesus shares, "My sheep hear My voice, I know them, and they follow Me." Where do we hear the voice of Jesus calling us to follow in the midst of other voices vying for our attention?

<u>August 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup></u>: All of us desire to follow Jesus, however, we come up with a list of excuses why we can't at the moment. We want to follow Jesus, but . . . ! How do we focus and make Him a higher priority in our lives?

August 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>: What is the cost of following Jesus? Discipleship is a daily journey of taking up our cross, focusing on Jesus, and following our Lord on a path of sacrificial service and love. It is a path of re-ordering our priorities to fit with God's priorities. Our Bible verses for the day are Luke 9:23-25.

#### **Feeding John**


#### **WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE A TELE-BUDDY?**


