Journeying with God

Life is full of ups and downs and challenges along the way. There is a misconception that if we follow God and believe in Him, life will all of a sudden be a lot simpler and easier, and we will be free from the burdens that plague everyone else. For those who have grown in their walk with Christ, many have found the struggles and challenges don't go away, and sometimes we face even greater challenges. The key difference for a person of faith, as opposed to someone who is not journeying with God, is that as Christians we know we are not alone in our journey, but that God goes with us. And it is often in facing those challenges with God's help that we grow stronger in our faith.

I think of the prophet Jeremiah whose message was challenging to hear for the people of Israel. He reminded them that they would go through a period of captivity and hardship in Babylon, but when that time of exile was ended God would fulfill His promise to bring restoration to them. We have that powerful verse in Jeremiah 29:11, "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." What a great reminder that God sees the bigger picture. While we are down in the trenches of life, we worry and fear and wonder if we are doing the right things or, even at times, if God is there. That's where trust comes in. I can picture God looking down and gently whispering in our ears, "Don't worry my child! I've got this, just trust me!"

It has been a journey for our congregation. We've gone through the trenches of Pastor Bobby's retirement, and the call committee and council's deliberating the best way to navigate the waters of current pastors' roles in conjunction with valuing the ministry of our sister congregations. With the current shortage of available pastors (which is true across all denominations), the well seemed a bit dry. In evaluating where the congregation should focus its priorities, the decision was made to also add an additional youth minister. Just when we were down in the trenches and wondered if we were going off the beaten path, God said, "Hang in there! Be patient and trust me! I've got this!"

As God always does, doors were opened. John LaRocque answered the call to fill the position of our youth minister for junior and senior high youth. He is already making great connections with youth and family in our congregation and community. Then another door opened, all the way from Germany, as Pastor Tobias Heike came for a visit and answered the call. A vote was taken by the congregation on August 17th to overwhelmingly extend the call to him. A phone call was made to him following the meeting, giving him time to respond. With excitement in his voice, he shared that he and his wife Christie had been praying and discussing this all week long, and their answer was an immediate "YES! We will accept the call! He called me later that afternoon, knowing that we have details to work out, as he will not be able to be with us until after the first of the year. But his words to me were, "Today is a day of celebration!"

God has been very good and has guided us through this time of transition. And now we look forward with much anticipation to all the things God has planned for us, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." God has opened some amazing doors for us, and now God invites us to respond as a congregation to offer support, both financial and otherwise, which includes our continued prayers and commitment to the future of what God has in store for Holy Ghost Lutheran Church. May we be reminded that we do not journey alone but that God journeys with us!






Church Picnic - October 12th, 2025






