

COUNCIL NOTES September 22, 2025

- The church council met on Monday, September 22, and opened the meeting at 5:58 with a Devotion from Pastor Steve from the C.S. Lewis book, "Mere Christianity."
- Judy Vordenbaum came to make a presentation to council about the lights in the church stairwells, and handicap access in the restrooms.
- 3. Mandy Herber came to present recommendations from Benefits Task Force on a housing allowance for Pastor Steve, and on staff salaries, and other benefits.
- 4. Heard that Pastor Tobias Heike's official start date with Holy Ghost will be February 1, 2026.
- The council is entertaining bids on security cameras for the Spirit Haus.
- 6. A building update was given on the Klaerner House. The demolition is complete. Construction will begin soon. Historical tax credits have been filed on the property.

- 7. Property Team will do an assessment of Parsonage 2 to see what repairs need to be made.
- 8. Discussed shifting council duty for church services to other volunteers, and allowing council to focus on primary duties.
- Will begin process for nominations for council in early October.
- Approved monthly meeting minutes & treasurers report, noting that income was above expenses for the month of August.
- 11. Adjourned the meeting at 8:37 p.m. to pair up and pray with prayer partners.

<u>Current Sermon Series - "Epic Fails – God Prevails"</u>
God's will prevails in the midst of the muddled mess we make of things in our lives and in this world. The Bible continually points to God's work in this world. The children at Kindernest often sing together: "My God is so great, so strong and so mighty, there's nothing my God cannot do." That one little verse expresses a basic truth that we see throughout the Bible: no matter how many times those who have gone before us have failed – God is still at work!



Messages in October

October 4th & 5th: "Epic Fails - God Prevails: David and Bathsheba"

King David committed adultery and then murdered Bathsheba's husband. God confronted David through the prophet Nathan and David was deeply moved and convicted of his sin. A humbled David cries out to the Lord, seeking forgiveness and restoration. In preparation for this weekend's message, please read 2nd Samuel chapters 11 and 12 and all of Psalm 51 (David's cry to the Lord).

October 11th & 12th: We step away from our sermon series this week as we celebrate together with our sister churches for the Annual Church Picnic at Gillespie County Fairgrounds. The theme is Rockin' & Rollin' in God's Word. There will be a Saturday evening service at 6 p.m. No 8 a.m. service, but everything will kick off at the fairgrounds at 9:15 with a presentation by Glenn Treibs on the history of Lutherans in Gillespie County, three-year-old Bibles, and activities for our Sunday School children. Worship will follow at 10:30 with our Cowboy Band doing some 50's Rock and Roll music with a Christian Theme. Then a great BBQ meal to follow with all the fixin's. There will be a silent auction to benefit our Youth, and other activities and events.

October 18th & 19th: "Epic Fails - God Prevails: King Solomon"

At the beginning of his reign, King Solomon asked God for wisdom to rule Israel wisely. He received that wisdom, but used it selfishly. Solomon's heart was turned to worshiping other gods and he built temples for them at the request of his many wives. (See 1st Kings 11:1-8.) How will God prevail? Praise the Lord that God's steadfast love endures forever.

October 25th & 26th: This is Reformation Weekend, and we continue our sermon series: Epic Fails; God Prevails, with a look at Jonah the prophet who went in the opposite direction from where God called him to go. Where do we struggle with where God is calling us?






