#### COUNCIL NOTES December 15, 2025

- 1. The meeting began with a devotion by Pastor David sharing "The Spirit of Christmas" written by Betty Ellebracht, reminiscing about the specialness of Christmas, even after the loss of a spouse.
- 2. Welcomed new council members.
- 3. Shared feedback of the bi-annual congregational meeting.
- 4. Parsonage 2 is in the process of some repairs and updates before pastor Tobias and family arrive in the new year.
- We have been asked to consider a gift to the North American Lutheran Church 20/20 Vision with it's four-fold emphasis of 1) raising up future church leaders,
   strengthening area support as the church grows,
   expanding our global witness through mission work, and 4) to foster growth and provide formative community for our seminary students.
- 6. Reminded council about coverage for our upcoming Christmas and Holiday services, and expanded covering using former council members in the new year.
- 7. Pastor Clint will be relocating his office to the Spirit Haus to make room for Pastor Tobias. Our sister congregations will help with those expenses.

- 8. Voted to approve the Compensation structure for IRS Tax savings purposes for Pastoral and Youth staff.
- 9. Council Retreat will be held on February 7.
- Information shared about the upgrade to computer security and server for the church office.
- 11. Heard reports from Kindernest, Children's Minister, and Youth Ministers.
- 12. Approved regular Meeting Minutes and Treasurer's reports.
- 13. Approved the recommendation from Investment Team for Randall Beckmann and Brenda Beaty who are re-upping for terms, and for Krisit Beyer to chair the team.
- 14. Elected Council leaders for 2026: President, Valeria Bonn; Vice President, Nick Thompson; Secretary, Rhonda Martin; and Treasurer, Jerry Gross.
- 15. The meeting adjourned at 7:39 pm, with council members teaming up to pray with one another.

#### **Current Sermon Series**

Our new sermon series for January is called: "I am with You!" The Lord God promises, throughout Scripture, to be present with His beloved children. Our seven-week series will explore several Scripture texts that reinforce the promises Jesus makes to us: "I am with you always." (Matt. 28:20)



#### **Messages in January**



- Sat. & Sun., Jan. 3 & 4: We begin this series, "I am with You," focusing on Jesus' promise to send The Advocate, the Holy Spirit to be with the church in the world today as Jesus was preparing to go back to the Father. Our text is from John 14:16-17.
- Sat. & Sun., Jan. 10 & 11: "Where two or three are gathered" The Lord God cares deeply about how His children treat one another and how they work through conflicts. The idea of Shalom (peace) is centered in reconciliation and well-being. Our passage for the weekend explores Matthew 18:15-22. In verse 20, Jesus promises that when we come together to seek reconciliation, He is with us!
- Sat. & Sun., Jan. 17 & 18: How often have you been afraid, or faced anxiety or apprehension about the future? Today we focus on two solid passages that remind us of God's presence in our most trying times, and that reminder that God is present with us. We look at Isaiah 41:10 and Psalm 23:4.
- Sat. & Sun., Jan. 24 & 25: "The Lord's Supper" The phrase: "In remembrance" held a deep, deep meaning in the ancient world of Jesus and the disciples. Jesus promises to connect us to Himself through this remarkable meal that is His gift to us! Please read through and meditate on Luke 22:14-20 in preparation for the weekend proclamation.
- Sat. & Sun., Jan. 31 & Feb. 1: When we are troubled and worried about our future salvation, Jesus reminds us of why He came. John 14:1-6 is a passage with a promise, that gives us great hope as we journey through this life and look forward to the promise that is to come.
