Lent: Parables of Jesus

January is coming to a close, and February is upon us. February is the month of valentines and love. What a perfect segue to Lent, and the season where we focus on the One who loved us so much that He was willing to go to the cross and die so that we might have forgiveness and eternal life. That person is Jesus, the only begotten Son of God. And during the season of Lent we journey with Jesus and remember all that He taught, and all that He did to bring that promise of eternal life through His suffering, death, and resurrection.

This year for our Lenten journey, for both our worship services and our Lenten devotional booklet, we will be journeying with Jesus through one of the primary methods He used to teach us about life and the kingdom of God—parables. Our word “parable” comes from the Greek. Parables are a fundamental part of Christian teaching which Jesus used in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke to convey profound spiritual truths in a form that was both relatable and memorable. Parables typically use everyday situations and examples to engage listeners and impart important lessons.

Jesus often used examples from nature, or from things that were common, ordinary, everyday things like bread, water, light, lamps, doors, sheep, and so forth. He used these common and familiar parts of life to convey a spiritual or heavenly meaning to guide us in our lives of faith. Jesus also used parables to challenge us with thought-provoking content to invite us to reflect more deeply on our lives and even to move us to have a change of heart.

Having read through the devotions, both Pastor Steve and myself were very pleased at the depth and content of many folks who shared their own personal stories and struggles of their faith. What a great resource that has been, and continues to be, as we walk through this season of Lent and journey with Jesus.

These parables will then be the focus for the messages for our weekend worship Services, as well as our Wednesday services, beginning with Ash Wednesday on February 18th. We will also be bringing back some short skits during the Wednesday evening services between Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday. Daniel will use his gifts and passions with theatre to bring some of these parables alive for us with a good cast and crew.

May God guide us as we journey together in faith, to understand more of the truths which Jesus taught us, and continue to grow in our faith journey, remembering also Jesus’ suffering, death, and resurrection as we move toward that great celebration of new life at Easter!

COUNCIL NOTES

January 26, 2026

1. Church Council met on January 26 by Zoom due to the weather.
2. Opening devotion was led by Pastor Steve at 6:03 p.m. on *New Beginnings* as we prepare for Pastor Heike to begin his ministry.
3. Jennifer Easterwood, our Financial Manager, was a guest and shared her vision and goals for the financial aspects of the church.
4. Due to an exceptional December in income, We were able to meet all of our obligations, and more. \$3,849 that was in other benevolence was given to Der Stadt Friedhof to assist with their work in enhancing the City Cemetery.
5. When we are blessed with extra income, we get to give a tithe of that to assist other ministries. \$5,000 was given to the N.A.L.C. for their 20/20 Vision emphasis. \$3,716.42 was given to the Golden Hub to help in their work of providing meals for the elderly.
6. Approved the Bi-Annual Meeting agenda for The February 22 Bi-Annual Meeting coming up. Along with that, designated three entities for distribution of the annual income from the Anniversary Trust Funds to be voted on at the meeting.
7. Pastor Clint has set up his office in the Spirit Haus to allow for Pastor Tobias to have office space.
8. Pastor Tobias made it to Austin, and will stay overnight due to weather. He will arrive in Fredericksburg on Tuesday, January 27.
9. Heard reports from Kindernest, Children's Ministry, and Youth Ministry.
10. Voted on the Grant Disbursements from the Investment Team, awarding grants totaling \$17,619.54 to seven different applicants for the 2025 year end.
11. Approved regular meeting minutes, and the Bi-Annual congregational minutes from the December meeting.
12. Approved the Treasurer's report, and thanked God for all those who were generous in their giving as we received over \$250,000 in income for the month of December.
13. Offered prayer over several prayer concerns and closed the meeting at 8:09 p.m.

Current Sermon Series

This month we will finish our sermon series, "I Am With You". On Ash Wednesday, February 18th, we will begin our Lenten journey with "Jesus in the Parables".

**Messages in February**

Sat. & Sun., Jan. 31/Feb. 1: We continue our sermon series "I Am with You", that great promise from John 14:1-6, where Jesus reminds us, "*Do not let your hearts be troubled, believe in God, believe also in me.*" Jesus has prepared a place for us, and that promise gives us a great foundation upon which to build our lives.

Sat. & Sun., Feb. 7 & 8: "I am With You: Through Service": Jesus promises to be with us in our lives through the power of the Holy Spirit and, miraculously, as we serve and care for our fellow human beings. Please read and consider carefully Matthew 25:31-46 as you prepare your hearts for worship.

Sat. & Sun., Feb. 14 & 15: "I am with you always til the end of time": Our "I am with You" series concludes with Jesus' parting words to the disciples in the Gospel of Matthew. Jesus proclaims one of the most important promises (*and Jesus never breaks a promise*) ever made to humanity: "And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Mt. 28:20 – NIV) What does this mean for us? Come and see!

Ash Wed., Feb. 18: We begin our Lenten journey with Jesus in the Parables with Luke 7:41-50 and **The Two Debtors**. On this Ash Wednesday when the ashes are placed on our forehead in the sign of the cross, and we remember our mortality; it also brings us before the foot of the cross, to humble us and remind us that Jesus paid the debt that we owe, and set us free from the bondage of sin.

Sat. & Sun., Feb. 21 & 22: Today's parable is from Matthew 20:1-16, The Workers in the Vineyard. While we cry out about fairness, Jesus reminds us of the abundance of God's grace which is sufficient for everyone of us.

Wed. Feb. 25: Luke 18:1-8 brings us to the parable of The Persistent Widow. While the parable is about a widow seeking justice, it reminds us of our need to be persistent in prayer coming before God our Father in every aspect of our lives to continue to build and strengthen our relationship with our Father in Heaven.

Sat. & Sun., Feb. 28/Mar. 1: The parable before us this weekend is the parable of The Watchful Servants from Luke 12:35-40. This parable reminds us about preparedness. Are we living our lives in such a way that if Jesus were to come, we'd be ready? Or do we need to make some adjustments in the way we are living?
