Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

As your newest pastor, I am very grateful to be able to open this March newsletter with a few words and reflections. We are now in the season of Lent; a season that spans the month of March and invites us into fasting. Not merely dietary fasting, but a fasting that intentionally removes something from our daily lives in order to make room for reflection, prayer, and attentiveness to God.

Lent is a somber time, a time of remembering what was sacrificed *for us* nearly 2,000 years ago. And as we draw closer to Holy Week and Easter, I ask you not to forget exactly that: to remember that you have been given an unfathomable gift - the hope of eternal life - despite all our personal failings. At the same time, remember that while this gift comes to you free of charge, given purely by grace, it is not a cheap token. Someone paid for the gift you received. Someone paid the highest price possible.

As our lives move steadily toward Good Friday, reflect on both of these events that could hardly be more different and yet are inseparably connected: Christ's dying and Christ's rising - the terrible price of sin borne by the innocent, and the astonishing gift of eternal life received by the unworthy. Praise God for this gift.

As we reflect, we are helped greatly by our Lenten devotionals. Take time to read the thoughts and stories of your neighbors and friends, who poured time, care, and effort into this wonderful little booklet that can guide you through the season. And please join us here at church for Lenten services every Wednesday at 11:00 a.m. or 6:30 p.m., as well as during our regular weekend services. Let us reflect together during this time that leads us to Jesus' cross. He had to go that way alone... **but we do not**, and we should be so thankful for that.

Speaking of thankfulness, let me take this opportunity to express how incredibly grateful I am to all of you who have taken the call to serve your neighbor so seriously. When I say that I was overwhelmed by your open arms and generous welcome, I am not using empty words. You prepared the parsonage with great love, making sure it was repaired, cleaned, and filled with necessities and food. You have showered me with welcome gifts, invitations, and - most importantly - your genuine love.

I have no way to thank each of you personally, and words alone feel insufficient. I hope instead to respond to this outpouring of hospitality and generosity by investing myself fully in this calling: by passing this love forward to you and to the wider community, and by being present for you when you need me. So let me close with the words of Jesus, which Pastor Steve reminded us of in a sermon last month: *"Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."*

Thank you again, and God's blessing to you in this season of Lent.

COUNCIL NOTES February 23, 2026

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:56 p.m. with an opening devotion by Pastor David on Making a Difference based on Galatians 6:9, “*Let us not grow weary in doing good.*”
2. David Bullion was with us to present an update on the Klaerner property. The project is about 20% complete. There were contingencies with the foundation that had to be addressed, and other items that might add some cost to the project.
3. Council addressed a major vision and goal for 2026 - to focus on worship and how we enhance that to fit the mission and vision and identity of the congregation while keeping values of excellence and preference as we move forward into the future to “Save the Lost and Strengthen the Saved”.
4. Spent time on follow-up from the bi-Annual congregational meeting.
5. Voted to put an additional \$10,000 toward the principle on our loan each month and revisit when we have a higher percentage of the Klaerner property completed.
6. Voted to cover half of Tobias’ moving expenses. The other half is covered by the military.
7. Shared about the worship and celebration planned for Pastor Tobias’s upcoming ordination on March 22 at 3 p.m.
8. Heard reports from Kindernest who added an additional staff person, and about plans for sprucing up the courtyard area between Kindnest and the Sanctuary.
9. Heard reports from the Children’s and Youth Ministers, and all the activities ongoing with our children and youth.
10. Voted on minutes from the previous meeting.
11. Voted on the treasurer’s report, stating that January started the year slow with more expenses than income.
12. Adjourned at 7:53 p.m. sharing joys and concerns around the table, and with a closing prayer by Pastor Tobias.

Current Sermon Series

Our current sermon series is called, "Jesus in the Parables."



Messages in March



Sat. & Sun., Feb. 28 & Mar. 1: The parable before us this weekend is the parable of The Watchful Servants from Luke 12:35-40. This parable reminds us about preparedness. Are we living our lives in such a way that if Jesus were to come, we'd be ready? Or do we need to make some adjustments in the way we are living?

Wed., Mar. 4: Today's message is based on The Lamp on a Stand in Matthew 5:14-16. In this parable we are given the charge by Jesus to let our light shine, not to point to ourselves or our own accomplishments, but to point to Christ and what He has done for us.

Sat. & Sun., Mar. 7 & 8: Luke 15:11-32 records that familiar parable of The Prodigal Son. Which person in this parable might you identify with? The prodigal son, the older brother, or the father? What does this text tell us about the gift of God's grace?

Wed., Mar. 11: What has value in our lives? What are we passionate about? Jesus shares two small but important words about those things that we treasure in Matthew 13:44-46.

Sat. & Sun., Mar. 14 & 15: In the account of The Good Samaritan, (Luke 10:25-37) Jesus challenges us to reach beyond ourselves to help those who are in need. This is about our Christian action that matches our deeds with our words, as we extend Christ's hand of love and encouragement and help to our neighbor in need.

Wed., Mar. 18: The parable of The Mustard Seed in Mark 4:30-32 reminds us that each of us can use the gifts that God has given us to make a positive impact on this world. Even a gift that we may consider insignificant or small, may have a more far-reaching impact than we could ever imagine.

Sat. & Sun., Mar. 21 & 22: Have you ever planted a garden? Then you can relate to this parable, but the seed that is being planted is the Word of God. The Sower and the Seed in Mark 4:1-20, shares the importance of planting the seed, and making sure we prepare the soil to receive that seed and have it grow and bear fruit.

Wed. Mar. 25: The Barren Fig Tree in Luke 13:6-9, is a harder parable for us to wrap our minds around. It does remind us to be persistent and patient, especially in our world today that expects immediate results. Sometimes you have to pile on the fertilizer, and see what results arise from that.

Sat. & Sun., Mar. 28 & 29: As we begin Holy Week how appropriate it is to focus on judgment day and the text from Matthew 25:31-46 about the sheep and the goats. Are we living our lives in such a way that we are serving Christ through serving our neighbor or those in need? How might we better live our lives to honor and serve Christ each day!


